Submissions should fall into at least one of the three topic areas: Organizational, Technical, and Interpersonal. They may come from campus administrators or members of the corporate community. At least one presenter needs to be an institutional representative.

We are seeking presentations on (but not limited to) the following:

- Business Continuity / Emergency Preparedness
- Integrating Student Services
- Data Security
- e-Payments / e-Billing
- Ethics in the Workplace
- Financial Literacy
- International Payments / Campuses
- Succession Planning

For selected submissions the presenter(s) will receive the following:

1. If one institutional representative serves as sole presenter, he/she will receive a complimentary registration to the conference, and travel expenses will be covered per NACUBO's travel guidelines.
2. If two (2) institutional representatives serve as presenters, each will receive a complimentary registration to the conference, and one representative will have travel expenses covered per NACUBO's travel guidelines.
3. No more than two institutional representatives will be given a complimentary registration
4. Corporate representatives serving as presenters are responsible for paying for their own registration and travel expenses.

To be considered for the 2010 program, complete the form below to provide information which must include the name of the presentation, as well as, a brief statement as to the issue/topic being addressed. Please note that a limited number of proposals will be accepted for inclusion.
