

Rodney H. Adams Endowment Management Award

Purpose: To recognize outstanding individual contributions to professional development activities in the area of college or university endowment and investment management. This award is not meant to singularly honor business acumen, but to recognize a dedication to the profession and skill in sharing knowledge and expertise with others.

Background: This award honors the late Rodney H. Adams, former treasurer of Stanford University, former trustee of Commonfund, and past chair of the NACUBO Investment Committee.

Nomination Process: Anyone in the higher education community or from investment management firms, and other relevant organizations may nominate an outstanding endowment management professional. (No self-nominations, please.) The selection committee will select a recipient, who will receive the award during NACUBO professional development programming.

Only one recipient will receive this prestigious award each year.

Selection Criteria: Rodney H. Adams Endowment Management award criteria include but are not limited to:

- Membership with NACUBO (employed by or retired from a NACUBO member college or university)
- A minimum of five years' experience in higher education endowment management
- Effectiveness in communicating endowment management techniques to business officers
- Design, development, and implementation of new professional development programs in endowment management
- Frequent, relevant articles and other written materials on endowment management
- Leadership in organizations that promote sound endowment management practices
- Advancement of professional endowment management practices
- Design, development, or implementation of innovative endowment management techniques

Award Details: The recipient will receive an inscribed plaque and complimentary registration to select NACUBO professional development programming.

Award Promotion: NACUBO will publicize news of the award recipients in national and local media outreach, as well as in the NACUBO *Current* newsletter and in other NACUBO media channels.
