

Student Financial Services Award

Purpose: To recognize individuals who demonstrate an outstanding commitment to the higher education community, NACUBO's advocacy efforts, and educational programs and publications in the area of student financial services.

Nomination Process: Anyone in the higher education community may nominate an outstanding student financial services professional. (No self-nominations, please.) The Student Financial Services Award Committee will select a recipient, who will receive the award during the NACUBO Student Financial Services Conference.

Only one recipient will receive this prestigious award each year.

Selection Criteria: Student Financial Services Award criteria include but are not limited to:

- Membership with NACUBO (employed by or retired from a NACUBO member college or university)
- Demonstrated leadership in shaping NACUBO advocacy efforts and policy positions, including developing legislative positions, drafting comments to federal agencies on proposed rules, serving on issue-specific task forces or advisory groups, or representing NACUBO before Congress or at federal agencies
- Contributions of time and expertise to the development and communication of guidance to share best management practices or that assist institutions' understanding of, and compliance with, laws and regulations
- Participation in the planning, content development, delivery, and review of NACUBO professional development programs, publications, and other services related to student accounts

Award Details: The recipient will receive an inscribed plaque and complimentary registration to the NACUBO Student Financial Services Conference.

Award Promotion: NACUBO will publicize news of the award recipients in national and local media outreach, as well as in the NACUBO *Current* newsletter and in other NACUBO media channels.
