



Daniel D. Robinson Accounting Award

Purpose: To recognize individuals who demonstrate leadership and a continuous commitment to the advancement of college and university accounting and reporting.

Background: This award honors Daniel D. Robinson, a retired partner with the accounting firm KPMG Peat Marwick, who was responsible for company services to higher education.

Nomination Process: Members of the higher education community are invited to nominate an outstanding higher education professional. (No self-nominations, please.) The NACUBO Higher Education Accounting Forum (HEAF) program committee and a NACUBO staff accounting expert will select a recipient to receive the award during HEAF.

Only one recipient will receive this prestigious award each year.

Selection Criteria: Daniel D. Robinson award criteria include but are not limited to:

- Membership with NACUBO (employed by or retired from a NACUBO member college or university)
- Contributions to the advancement of college and university accounting, reporting, and fiscal management through service to the higher education sector and business officer profession
- Collaboration with and service to standards-setting organizations, such as the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB), Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB), and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA)
- Participation with federal agencies in the development of rules or regulations that involve a knowledge of higher education accounting and reporting
- Development or implementation of innovative approaches to accounting requirements or issues
- Creation, dissemination, or interpretation of material relevant to accounting standards/practices, including publications, articles, or presentations

Award Details: The recipient will receive an inscribed plaque and complimentary registration to HEAF.

Award Promotion: NACUBO will publicize news of the award recipients in national and local media outreach, as well as in the NACUBO *Current* newsletter and in other NACUBO media channels.
