Brontè Jones joined Dickinson College as the Treasurer and Vice President for Finance and Administration in September 2013. Previous leadership positions include Treasurer of St. John's College in Annapolis, Maryland and Vice President for Administration and Finance at Huston-Tillotson University in Austin, Texas.

In addition to her role at Dickinson, Dr. Jones is a member of the National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO) – Small Institutions Council, Board Member and Treasurer of HERS, and member of the Middle States Commission on Higher Education.

In 2008, Dr. Jones was honored with the Fannie Lou Hamer Humanitarian Award for her community involvement in the Annapolis area. She also received a NAACP Lifetime Achievement Award in recognition of her appointment as the first person of color to serve as an executive officer in the 310-year history of St. John's College.

Additionally, she is a graduate of the Harvard Institute for Higher Education and the HERS Wellesley Institute. Jones holds a bachelor's degree in finance and an MBA from American University and a doctorate in higher-education administration from the University of Texas, Austin.
